### VI. Principals report

- Report of 2017-2018 budget Hourly rates were off because of higher estimates. Some aids, tutors still need to be paid. The ammendment is in review, we should be on tack on the budget, Money is used for AVID, Technology, and Planning,
- b. Review CSIP/Land Trust registration submitted Keeping Ds and Fs, our Math goal is similar, we have added a reading goal (critical reading strategies), climate goal (proposing 30 minute block of time weekly to promote AVID and social-emotional learning, specific curriculum and planned out. 69% of teachers are on board, want to have it planned by end of year)
- c. Cell tower money End of year stipends for Department chairs and Student Support Teams previously approved
- d. SPED We are receiving and ABS Unit (Behavior unit) at our school next year. District is moving units around to even out the units. We will keep the Extended Core Unit.
